Sec. 18-27. Utility charges.

Effective with bills issued on and after July 1, 2007 2008, the consumer shall pay charges for utility service in accordance with the following schedules:

(a) Monthly service charges. The monthly service charge shall be:

- (1) Customer cost charge. A customer cost charge of \$1.70 for each service account. However, customers who have only a water account or a wastewater account shall pay a customer cost charge of \$3.40.
- (2) Commodity cost charge.
 - (i) Water: \$1.24 per 100 cubic feet (Ccf).
 - (ii) Wastewater: ~~\$1.31~~ \$1.39 per 100 cubic feet (Ccf).
- (3) Capacity cost charge.
