# Conference about disabilities scheduled

The Third Annual Wide Open Doors Conference will be held Oct. 18 and 19 at the Woolridge Road Church, located at 5130 Woolridge Road.

The conference will include more than 20 workshops on topics, including special education, autism, ADHD, assistive technology, grassroots advocacy, social skills, music therapy and many others.

Keynote speakers will be Nina Fuller and Patrick Henry Hughes. Fuller is the founder of Living Proof Testimonies and S.M.I.L.E.

on Down Syndrome. She is also the author of "Special Strengths for Special Parents."

Hughes was born with no eyes, no ability to straighten his arms and legs, and has had steel rods attached to his spine to correct scoliosis. Even so, he began playing the piano at 9 months old, and he plays the trumpet and sings. With the help of his father, who maneuvers Hughes' wheelchair, he participates in the University of Louisville School of Music marching and pep bands.

for a parent or person with a disability, and \$60 for all others. After Aug. 15, each fee increases by \$20.
